



Day 1: Welcome to Iceland!

- Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach: Stroll along the dramatic black sand beach, famous for its towering basalt columns, powerful waves, and the Reynisdrangar sea stacks rising from the ocean.

In the evening, we'll arrive in the charming village of Vík, where you'll check into your hotel for the night. Use the time to relax, enjoy dinner at leisure, and take advantage of the hotel's hot tub and sauna to soak in the serenity of this picturesque location.

Evening Northern Lights Tour

Depending on the Northern Lights forecast, join a guided tour included in your trip to search for the mesmerizing Northern Lights. The remote location, away from city lights, offers an excellent chance to witness this natural phenomenon if conditions are favorable.

Day 3: Explore Glaciers, Canyons, and Diamond Beach

FAQS

WHERE DOES THE TRIP START & FINISH?

The trip starts and finishes in Reykjavík.

DO YOU HAVE AGE LIMIT FOR TOURS?

Our tours are designed for adventurous travelers aged 18 to 45, with most guests typically between 21 and 35 years old. However, anyone with a sense of adventure is welcome, as long as they are 18 or older!

WHAT IS THE GROUP SIZE FOR EACH TRIP?

Each trip typically has between 4 to 15 travelers, allowing for a more personalized and immersive experience.

WHAT KIND OF ACCOMMODATION IS INCLUDED ON THIS TRIP?

We stay in double or triple occupancy rooms at 3-star hotels, sharing with other trip members. Private rooms are available for an additional fee.

DO YOU ASSIST WITH VISAS?

We do not handle visa arrangements. However, we're happy to help you gather information about visa requirements based on your nationality for your chosen destination, ensuring you have a clear understanding of what's needed.

WHAT IS THE CURRENCY?

The currency in Iceland is the Icelandic Krona (ISK). Most places accept credit and debit cards, but it's always a good idea to have some cash on hand for smaller purchases or remote areas.

IS MY MONEY PROTECTED?

Yes, your money is safe! If the trip is canceled by us, including due to not meeting the minimum participant requirement by the deadline (typically two months before the trip), you'll receive a full refund.

IS TRAVEL INSURANCE REQUIRED FOR THIS TRIP?

Yes, we strongly recommend purchasing comprehensive travel insurance that covers cancellation, personal injury, medical and repatriation expenses, evacuation, personal liability, and loss of personal property before traveling with us. We can also recommend travel insurance options based on your country of residence to ensure you're fully covered. Make sure your policy also covers any activities you'll be participating in, especially adventure or high-risk activities, for all the adrenaline junkies out there!

CANCELLATION POLICY

We understand plans can change. A \$200 deposit secures your spot, and you can cancel within 72 hours for a full refund. The remaining balance is due 60 days before the trip. If you cancel 60+ days before, you'll get a full refund minus a \$100 cancellation fee. Cancellations made less than 60 days before the trip are non-refundable. WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Pack warm, waterproof layers! Bring a heavy coat, thermals, sweaters, waterproof pants, and sturdy boots with good grip. Don't forget a hat, scarf, gloves, and a swimsuit for the hot springs. Layering is key to staying warm and comfortable!

HOW DOES GAGAGO ENSURE A GREAT GROUP DYNAMIC FOR ITS TRIPS?

Gagago trips are designed for small groups with specific criteria to create the best experience for everyone. BOOKING CONDITIONS

We understand that sometimes plans change, and you may need to cancel your trip reservation. Please review our cancellation policy carefully before booking a spot on our trip.

1. Down Payment

To secure your spot on the trip, a deposit of \$200 is required at the time of booking. This down payment ensures your reservation and covers administrative and planning expenses.

2. Free Cancellation Period

You have the option to cancel your reservation within 72 hours of booking without any penalty or charges. During this period, you will receive a full refund of any payments made, including the down payment.

3. Remaining Payment

The remaining balance of the total trip cost is due no later than 60 days before the trip start date. Failure to make this payment by the specified deadline may result in the cancellation of your reservation, and the down payment will not be refunded.

4. Cancellation 60 or More Days Before Trip Start

If you cancel your reservation 60 or more days before the trip start date, the remaining balance you have paid will be fully refunded. You'll receive a trip credit for your deposit, minus a \$100 cancellation fee.

5. Cancellation Less Than 60 Days Before Trip Start

If you cancel your reservation less than 60 days before the trip start date, the full payment (total amount) that you have paid is non-refundable.

6. Refund Process

7. Transferring Reservation
