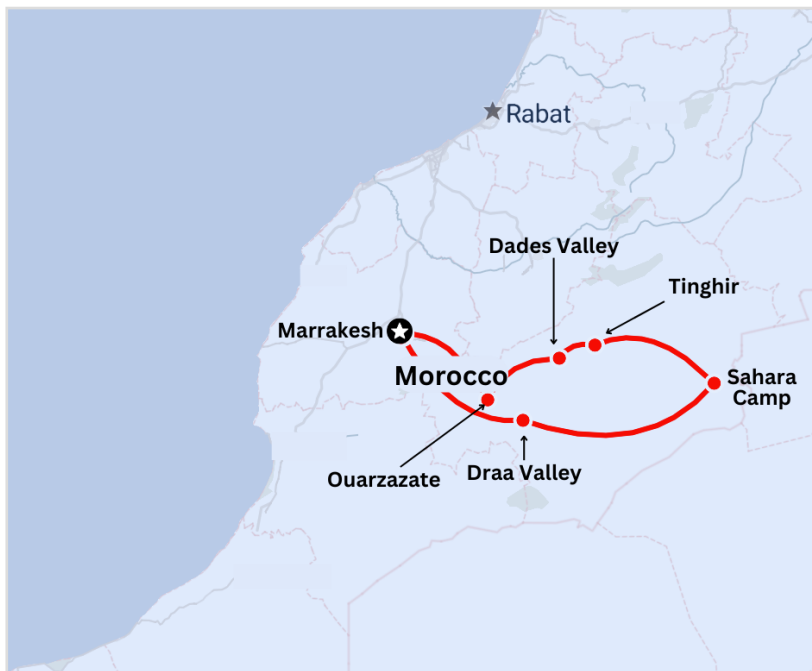

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Marrakech

Day 2: Marrakech City Tour

Today, we'll immerse ourselves in Marrakech's rich history and culture. We'll finish the tour at the lively **Djemma el Fnaa** square, where street performers, food stalls, and market vendors create a truly dynamic atmosphere.

In the **late afternoon** (around 4:00 PM), we'll dive into a hands-on **cooking class**, starting with a visit to a local souk to gather fresh ingredients. With the guidance of an expert chef, we'll prepare an authentic **Moroccan tagine** and then enjoy the fruits of our labor at dinner. Alternatively, depending on the group's preference, we can opt for a **street food tour** instead, sampling a variety of local delicacies from the vibrant street stalls.

Day 3: High Atlas Mountains - Tizi-N-Tichka - Ait Benhaddou - Ouarzazate

Today, we'll embark on a scenic journey through the majestic **High Atlas Mountains**, crossing the dramatic **Tizi-N-Tichka Pass**, the highest in Morocco. Along the way, enjoy breathtaking views of the rugged mountain landscapes and traditional Berber villages.

Our next stop is the UNESCO World Heritage site of **Ait Benhaddou**, a striking ksar (fortified village) famous for its mud-brick architecture and its appearance in numerous films. We'll explore the ancient kasbahs and learn about the history of this iconic location.

In the afternoon, we'll continue to **Ouarzazate**, known as the "Gateway to the Desert." Here, we'll visit the **Kasbah Taourirt**, a beautiful historical palace, and explore the town's connection to the film industry.

Day 04: Ouarzazate - Skoura Oasis - Roses Valley - Dades Valley

Known for its annual Rose Festival, this valley is a picturesque stop, where the surrounding mountains and fields are filled with the scent of roses. We'll visit a local cooperative to learn about rose water production and perhaps pick up some fragrant rose products.

From there, we'll enter the scenic **Dades Valley**, known for its dramatic red-rock gorges and ancient kasbahs. After enjoying the breathtaking landscapes and traditional Berber villages, we'll arrive at our hotel in the valley for dinner and relaxation.

Next, we'll pass through **Erfoud**, a gateway to the Sahara, famous for its fossil-rich landscapes. Here, we'll transition from the mountains to the desert as we make our way to the majestic **Erg Chebbi dunes** in the Sahara Desert.

Enjoy a magical sunset with optional camel ride and spend the night at a luxury desert camp, immerse yourself in live Berber music, savor a delicious Moroccan dinner, and gaze at a sky filled with endless stars.

Day 06: Sahara Desert Erg Chebbi - Rissani - Alnif - Draa Valley - Agdez

Our journey begins with a stop in **Rissani**, a historic town known for its traditional souks and as the birthplace of Morocco's royal family. You'll have a chance to explore its vibrant market and learn more about local life in the region.

Next, we'll travel through the desert landscape to the small town of **Alnif**, before entering the lush and expansive **Draa Valley**, one of Morocco's most scenic regions, filled with endless date palms, ancient kasbahs, and traditional Berber villages.

Our day ends in **Agdez**, a tranquil town at the edge of the valley, where you'll settle into your accommodation for the evening, surrounded by beautiful desert landscapes.

WHERE DOES THE TRIP START & FINISH?

The trip starts and finishes in Marrakesh.

WHICH AIRPORT I NEED TO FLY INTO AND OUT FROM?

Marrakesh Menara Airport (RAK)

DO YOU HAVE AGE LIMIT FOR TOURS?

Our tours are designed for adventurous travelers aged 18 to 45, with most guests typically between 21 and 35 years old. However, anyone with a sense of adventure is welcome, as long as they are 18 or older!

WHAT IS THE GROUP SIZE FOR EACH TRIP?

Each trip typically has between 5 to 15 travelers, allowing for a more personalized and immersive experience.

WHAT KIND OF ACCOMMODATION IS INCLUDED ON THIS TRIP?

We stay in double or triple occupancy rooms at 3 and 4 star hotels, sharing with other trip members. For the Sahara Desert adventure, you'll experience a stay in a luxury desert camp, complete with well-furnished tents, full beds, private en-suite bathrooms, running water, and electricity for a comfortable yet authentic desert experience.

DO YOU ASSIST WITH VISAS?

We do not handle visa arrangements. However, we're happy to help you gather information about visa requirements based on your nationality for your chosen destination, ensuring you have a clear understanding of what's needed.

WHAT IS THE CURRENCY?

The currency in Morocco is the Moroccan Dirham (MAD).

When traveling to Morocco, it's easy to exchange major currencies like USD, EUR, or GBP for dirhams at exchange bureaus, banks, or ATMs. Credit cards are also widely accepted in larger cities, but it's always good to have some cash on hand for smaller markets or rural areas.

IS MY MONEY PROTECTED?

Yes, your money is safe! If the trip is canceled by us, including due to not meeting the minimum participant requirement by the deadline (typically two months before the trip), you'll receive a full refund.

IS TRAVEL INSURANCE REQUIRED FOR THIS TRIP?

Yes, we strongly recommend purchasing comprehensive travel insurance that covers cancellation, personal injury, medical and repatriation expenses, evacuation, personal liability, and loss of personal property before traveling with us. WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Dress modestly in Morocco. Women should cover shoulders and knees with loose clothing, while men should avoid shorts and sleeveless tops. Lightweight, breathable fabrics are ideal for the heat.

In the desert, pack layers for cooler nights and bring sun protection like hats and sunglasses. Comfortable walking shoes are a must for exploring cities.

CAN I JOIN THE TRIP ON MY OWN?

Yes, you can absolutely join the trip on your own, and we highly recommend it! Over 90% of our travelers come solo, and it's the perfect way to enjoy a life-changing experience while making new friends from around the world. Our trips are designed to help you bond and socialize, so you won't feel like the odd one out. 3. Remaining Payment
